This course provides an intensive training for scientists interested in the ecology of microorganisms within a range of environments, offering students practical hands-on experience in:

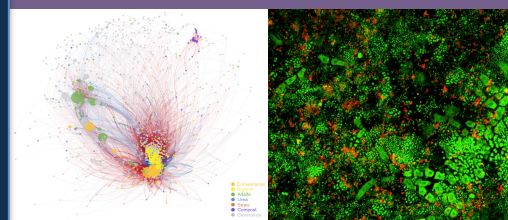
- Experimental/ sample design and statistical analysis
